 - Department is working diligently doing K9 searches on the secondary campuses last search

 vape pen
 - Mental health is still a concern feel that there is a need for more resources WPD is creating a crisis prevention team that would help in that area
- WISD Health Update
 - COVID is currently going great did have a surge but things are looking much better today there are only 12 active cases from close to 400 about a month ago
 - Drug testing started in October Feb. results are not in yet; company has been taking twice as long as it has in the past – of 10-12 positives for marijuana only 1 is a repeat positive
 - The district is going to offer free athletic physicals again this year on May 2 and May 9
