# SHAC Updates

- REACH Update
  - Still working on location for prom event and tying down loose ends will share information with campuses once it is all finalized
  - o Annual fundraiser on Feb. 12 (5K Cupid Shuffle)
- WISD Counseling Updates
  - Next Step Counselor report for 1<sup>st</sup> semester had 249 referrals across the district; 180 of the referrals were seen by a counselor – campus with most referrals is WHS who has enough referrals they could use 2 full time counselors instead of 1
  - Next Step hosted a parent night for suicide prevention and awareness in December had 24 attendees – going to do another presentation in March with students and parents of 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades targeted
- WISD Security Update
  - No updates at this time
- WISD Health Update
  - COVID has surged again at noon on 1/12 WISD had 312 cases WISD COVID dashboard is updated daily – district is watching the information very closely
  - Drug testing started in October have had 3 sessions so far
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> session of testing in December 2 positives for THC at WHS 1 student was a first time positive and the other student was a 2<sup>rd</sup> time positive being retested due to being positive in a previous testing session

### SHAC Presentations

- American Heart Association Employee Wellness Program not able to make it to meeting but WISD will be utilizing this wellness program
- WISD Human Sexuality Curriculum topic comes from Texas legislation school boards are delegating
  to SHAC committees to meet at least 2 times to discuss the curriculum and take a recommendation to
  the school board on which curriculum to use
  - WISD currently uses "Choosing the Best" curriculum on an "opt-in" option sending a link to all
     SHAC to review and will discuss further at next meeting
- Child Abuse, Family Violence, Dating Violence and Sex Trafficking Curriculum Senate Bill 9 changed the education code required curriculum on child abuse, family violence, dating violence and sex trafficking
  - Sub-committee will be formed within SHAC because the bill requires the adoption of new curriculum to be approved by the board

- 2021-22 SHAC Sub Committees
  - Coordinated School Health Program Review district continuing with CATCH program (Coordinated Approach to Child Health) for grades K-8
    - o Working on getting representative to come speak at SHAC meeting
  - Child Abuse, Family Violence, Dating Violence and Sex Trafficking Curriculum
