QUESTIONS FROM THE CEIC COMMITTEE to DEIC:

The 5th grade teacher that was asked to be self-contained this year is frustrated that the student readers for the new ELAR curriculum are still on backorder. As we are already in the second nine-weeks, she feels that not having all the resources has a negative effect on student achievement.

Several committee members would like the district to consider hiring an additional paraprofessional to cover ISS and unfilled absences. Clift's ISS numbers are higher than all of the other elementary schools as well as one junior high and we are consistently not having substitutes to cover when teachers are out. This creates an issue when our iTime paras are pulled to cover classes instead of meeting with their intervention groups. This is a daily issue in one of these two areas.
