## Minutes January 27, 2021 Crisis Management Team Regular Meeting Waxahachie Independent School District

The Crisis Management Team of the Waxahachie Independent School District met on January 27, 2021, for a Regular Meeting. Philip Gurke made a motion for approval of Minutes from the previous meeting. Tonya Harris seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion Items:

- Discussion of implementation of National Incident Management System (NIMS) emergency management training for necessary district personnel – the want it to have campus administrators forgo NIMS training which is an additional tool for schools and what school safety programs are based on – Thomas Griffith is currently working on a NIMS training that would apply directly to our district
- Discussion of WISD's response to COVID and update regarding current conditions the county is seeing a decline in numbers – the test positivity rate has decreased as well from around 40% of people tested are positive to around 20% - hospitals are also seeing a decline – a large vaccination hub has been approved by the state but there are no vaccines available currently to be able to open it but hoping to open in the next 2 weeks

Raul Gomez made a motion to adjourn. Kam Bridgers seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 12:56 p.m.
