Oliver was promoted to Lieutenant on June 16, 2020; since taking leadership in March 2020 there has been a few standards set for Security team such as a physical agility test and training at the WPD gun range; moving forward there will be additional training on situation de-escalation, mental health and crisis intervention; consideration regarding the placement of security officers on campuses; Belvis Noland will be Security Lead; better the communication between security and administrators; updating the policies and procedures and will be sharing with administrators; raising the bar on accountability; raising the bar on quality of officers and making the department a team.

- Discussion and possible action to approve changes to the District Crisis Management Plan motion was made by Thomas Griffith with a second by Kim Kriegel to move the updated District Crisis Plan to the Board for approval, and passed with a unanimous decision.
- Discussion regarding action plan to address recommendations within the 2020 tri-annual security audit committee was made aware that the Board would receive a copy of the audit report along with a corrective action plan developed by Lt. Oliver at the board meeting July 13, 2020.
- An update was given regarding the Safety and Security Grant the metal detectors have been received and assembled - 9 are at WHS, 2 at each junior high campus, and 5 left to put at elementary campuses - they can be moved if needed at any type of event
