The meeting was called to order at 4:30 PM by Assistant Superintendent of Elementary Learning Lisa Mott. She led the committee in reciting the district's motto and asked the members to share Good Things.

Dr. Hollingworth welcomed the members. He shared the excitement regarding the SSEP projects and next steps for students to get their science experiment ready to be launched into space! Students and staff will attend the lift-off at the Kennedy Space Center and later on to the Smithsonian to present their products. Regarding the recent District Deep Dive professional development days, this structure was very well received by the staff during January training days. He asked the committee to keep that in mind when developing the 2024-2025 school calendar. The board will finalize the rezoning plan to meet the attendance needs of the new schools and effectively distribute student populations. He gave background information on the recent naming of comprehensive high school #2 as Waxahachie Creek High School.

Ms. Kubin reviewed the progress on Title funds expenditures. In Plan4Learning, she shared the formative assessment completions for the district and campus improvement plans. Comprehensive Needs Assessment requirements and committee member training will be addressed at a later meeting.

Mrs. Mott clarified district requirements that must be met when developing the calendar. Homecoming and Fair Day are not set as yet and won't be announced until early February. She led the committee in reviewing the edited calendar reflecting feedback from the previous DEIC meeting. The committee broke up into small groups to look for trends in feedback gleaned from district departments and campuses. Dr. Hollingsworth clarified any misconceptions. Committee members shared-out their findings of common themes from the feedback followed by sharing out of possible calendar edit recommendations. Mott shared another calendar option that adds five minutes to each day that would give more flexibility, allow the end of the school year to fall before Memorial Day, Global HS would be able to host graduation on a student holiday, and give staff a mini Fall break.

With all the feasible possibilities, Mrs. Mott asked the committee members to go back to their respective campuses or departments to gain more feedback from staff. The committee will reconvene on Thursday, Feb. 1, 2023 to make final calendar recommendations.

The meeting was adjourned by Mrs. Mott at 6:05 PM.

- The Calendar must include 75,600 minutes of instruction
- Teachers must work 187 days
 - Having fewer days of instruction requires more
 Work Days or Professional Development days
- Expectations
 - 2 bad weather days, Fair Day, Parent/Teacher Conferences, Homecoming
- Flexibility
 - Start and End dates, Holiday Breaks, Early Release, Designated Professional Learning or Work Days



Calendar Option #3 "Wishes"

Start date from moved from Monday to Wednesday

Repurposed 11/4 off to allow for a mid week start

Professional day of 2/21 was moved to 2/24

Good Friday PL and holiday on Monday after Easter were flipped

Pushed to last day past Memorial Day in order to accommodate the mid-week late start (Opening Jimmy Ray)

Added an additional PL day prior to school star. Removed the work day after the last day in May

Quick Glance - DEIC edited calendar

- Prior to school, 3 PD days and 2 work days
- Teachers return on Thursday, August 6, 2024
- Teachers last day is Friday, May 29, 2025
- School starts on Wednesday, August 14, 2024
- School ends on Thursday, May 29, 2025
- Includes traditional holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break)
- Includes 7 Professional Learning/PLC days within the school year (9/20, 10/25, 11/15, 1/7, 2/14, 3/17, 4/21)
- Includes 2 Early Release days (12/20, 5/29)
- 76,980 minutes of instruction (3 built in days)
- 1st semester = 82 days 2nd semester = 90 days
