The District Educational Improvement Committee met on September 30, 2021, at 5:30 PM at the WISD Curriculum & Instruction Building.

Assistant Superintendent Dr. David Averett welcomed everyone and each member introduced themselves. Dr. Averett introduced district superintendent Dr. Jerry Hollingsworth. Dr. Hollingsworth thanked everyone for giving their time to improve district education. He shared the State of the District with the Committee including the vision and values process the district is currently going through which includes a district and community survey. Survey results will be reviewed by different teams, including a team of students, to articulate and align the results. In depth interviews will be held with various individuals. The end goal is 4-6 core values related to education in Waxahachie that all future decisions will be based upon.

The 2021-22 DEIC meeting format was explained. Typically, an overview of a district project or program will be presented, work will be done on the District Improvement Plan, and the next academic calendar will be developed.

The calendar development process will include:

- Presentation and discussion of 3-4 calendar options that meet the required parameters, including instructional minutes, contract days, etc.
- Members take options back to campuses for review and to gather feedback.
- Tweaking calendars to achieve a balance between being campus-driven and district-driven with the priority of being what's best for children.
- Reaching a sufficient consensus for a calendar to be presented for Board approval.

Dr. Averett gave direction on the District Improvement Plan activity related to Goal 1: Performance Objective 1 strategies. Small groups worked together to review the strategies, color code them as to if the strategies work, need to be adjusted, or need to be removed. Members could also list suggestions for adjustment or additional strategies.
