As the school year starts to wind down, expectations in school remain high. Parents have a huge influence on their child's attitude and connection to school. Parents are encouraged to:

- Maintain clear and consistent rules at home, such as how much screen time is allowable both on school nights and on weekends.
- Do fun things as a family, such as playing games, reading, and going to events in the community.
- Recognize accomplishments.
- Talk with your child about school, friends, and things he/she looks forward to in the future.
- Teach your child how to solve problems with others by: asking him/her open-ended questions, helping them brainstorm solutions rather than assign blame, teaching assertive skills, and role-playing different scenarios.
- Use encouraging statements with your child, like "You've got this," when your child is struggling or facing a challenge.
