- Welcome
 - Mrs. Authier welcomed everyone
- Mrs. Authier reminded the committee that early voting is going on now through April 27th. Election day is May 1st.
- CNA Committees - Each CNA committee shared the findings from their committee meetings. Mrs. Authier relayed that the information shared will be used to refine the Campus Improvement Plan and set goals for the 2021-22 school year.
 - Demographics--Coach Hargrove shared about student diversity, staff diversity, the lottery program, recruiting of diverse staff, growing staff from paraprofessionals to teachers.
 - Processes and Programs--Survey sent to certified staff; Strengths--implementation of math curriculum (STEMscopes); assessment data to improve instruction; Areas to Improve- implementation of ELAR curriculum with fidelity - Fountas and Pinnell/Pearson - possibly chunk the units with the curriculum and instruction department; planning process; consistent student goal setting campus-wide
 - Student Achievement-- Strengths - Large growth of 5th grade students in comparison with their third grade data; campus benchmarks have been at the district level or above; based on TAPR, our staff retention rate is higher than the state average; Areas to Improve --Writing is lower in STAAR meets and masters--work on vertical alignment; focus on writing in all content areas; differentiation and inclusive instructional practices to increase economically disadvantaged and special education student performance on state/district assessments
 - Perceptions--Strengths - Staff/Student/Parent Surveys were positive, high satisfaction rate among each group and within all areas
Areas to Improve: Physical structure of the front office - lack of barrier between front office and classrooms--Mrs. Authier shared that the district is working on making the area secure; security guard is not visible--this is from the first semester, as our second

semester security officer is much more visible; dismissal concern with long car line;
Strengthen NISE strategies implementation
