Makerspace Volunteers: Trying to fill the volunteer spots for Creation Station and Design Den

We have a schedule but additional volunteers are needed to fill the open time slots. If a volunteer can only come for an hour each week, that would be great!

The question came up as to whether high school students could come volunteer. Mrs. Lavender noted that we would have to ask for those students, and we could look into that for next year. It was also suggested that we could contact the NHS sponsor at the highschool.

Mr. Wilson suggested that we contact United Way. Mrs. Loafman will reach out to her Partners in Education business as well.

Theatre Program: We were looking at Coleman to use for our musical that we are starting in the spring, but we have not decided on a location. The money was donated by two sponsors to cover the cost of purchasing the musical from MTI. The rehearsals will be after school, and will be led by Mrs. Authier and Mrs. Polk. The program will be open to third-fifth grade students, and tryouts will take place to fill the roles. Mr. Reynolds at WHS has expressed support and would like to have his highschool theatre students assist as well.

Title I Funds: \$5,000 dollars—\$458 is going towards Math STEMscopes. Last year we spent the money for a tutor. The board approved another paraprofessional position, so a tutor may not be needed this year. The committee was asked if they had other ideas on needs for our campus that the money could go towards.

Mrs. Authier noted that we are looking at Scholastic to see about giving free books to every student as a family event. A teacher suggested Scholastic News, Flocabulary, and Pebble Go add on.
