  - Mrs. Authier welcomed everyone
- Title One Funds/CIP Review
  - Mrs. Authier shared our Campus Improvement Plan, particularly the Priority Problem statements on p. 14. Mrs. Authier walked through each of the 5 problem statements:
    - Problem Statement 1: Student academic regression possible due to COVID-19 shutdown in the Spring of 2020.
    - Problem Statement 2: All staff have exterior keys to access doors without badge access and doors are sometimes left unlocked.
    - Problem Statement 3: Wilemon cannot participate in online district or state testing to the level of other campuses across the district.
      - This has improved to approximately 5 chromebooks in each of 3rd-5th grade classrooms
    - Problem Statement 4: Student social-emotional needs due to COVID-19 shutdown in the Spring of 2020.
    - Problem Statement 5: Additional support and time needed to refine and enhance project-based learning STEAM instruction
      - Campus now has Defined Learning - a project based learning resource

- Title One Funds--Wilemon still has funds left
  - Idea of getting STEM kits for each student and do a Facetime Live and have families join in and all do a project together - in place of campus family night
  - Mrs. Harris shared how she included STEM projects in Online Learning
  - Approximately \$10,000 left to spend
  - Have already purchased: Reading A-Z for Kinder/1st, Scholastic News K-5, Math Fluency Kits, STEMscopes streaming, Coding via STEMscopes, Diving Into Engineering Kits
  - Possibly purchase a Swivel; Mrs. Cieri shared that it would need a designated ipad
