Personal Safety Lessons

In continuation of October's guidance lessons, we will learn strategies for staying safe at home, at school, on technology, and in the community. In these lessons, we will learn basic rules for personal safety, allowing students to know what to do when faced with a problematic or potentially dangerous situation. We will discuss where and who to go to for help.

"Play it Safe" is a research-based personal safety curriculum designed to teach children how to stay safe from all types of abuse. The elementary curriculum is age-appropriate and grade specific. However, each grade level is introduced to the "safety rule," which is:

- Say No!
- Get away when you can
- Always tell a trusted adult.
