2. Campus/District Concerns

If students are not completing the work when they go to Saturday school, what happens? They are doing time but still not doing the work.

Answer (Zandt) - If a student does not complete the assigned work but makes up the seat time by going to Saturday school or tutoring, then they meet the requirement for TEA Attendance 90% rule.
