Mission:

Update on goals:

- There are 6 active goals with a problem statement for each one.
- The campus is changing in demographics and we need to be aware of intervention strategies to target instruction for all of our learners. Several strategies are tied to monitoring students by student programming and demographics. As a campus we are monitoring all students and specific programs such as: GT, ELLS, 504, and SPED students to ensure interventions are effective.
- Teachers have been given training for new initiatives for the district such as Branching Minds and Map. These two platforms are to help assist with monitoring and closing the achievement gap. We are making progress with these programs.
- Goal 1 Strategy 5: Teachers will utilize LLI for intervention. At this time LLI is provided through our Reading Interventionist and teachers will utilize guided reading in the classroom. This strategy needs to be suspended. At this time we are having Angela Morgan our Reading Instructional Coach assessing our current leveled literacy library for feedback.
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The campus would like to look into grammar and phonics programs to assist with a campus wide plan for writing.

Announcements/ Positives:

Updates on construction for the campus/ updates:

- This year we are going to repaint the outside of the building. Bids are currently taking place.
- We are currently working on getting new blinds, counter tops, addressing the lockers, and other campus updates. There is a planned walkthrough with Mr. Gomez this semester.
- Shackelford will have their sign updated to a wireless server.
- Powerwash the outside of the building.
- This summer the maintenance team renovated the roof.
- It has been brought to maintenance attention about the carpet removal. There are plans to start on this project this year.
